

Minister of Commerce Wang Wentao and Minister of Economic Development of Honduras Announce the Launch of China-Honduras FTA Negotiations

On July 4, Minister of Commerce Wang Wentao and Minister Fredis Cerrato of Economic Development of Honduras announced on behalf of their governments the launch of China-Honduras FTA negotiations.

On March 26, 2023, China established diplomatic relations with Honduras, heralding a new stage for bilateral trade and economic cooperation. On June 12, President Xi Jinping held talks with visiting President Xiomara Castro. The two sides issued a joint statement announcing their consensus on launching FTA negotiations.
