- 1. Uruguay maintains the following designated import and export monopoly: ANCAP (Administración Nacional de Combustibles Alcohol y Portland)
- 2. Brazil reserves the right to maintain or designate import and export monopolies in the following sectors:
 - a) Petroleum, gas and other hydrocarbons
 - b) Nuclear minerals
