9th Round Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership Negotiations

The ninth round of U.S. - EU negotiations on the Transatlantic Trade and Investment Partnership (TTIP) agreement will take place in New York, NY from 20 to 24 April 2015. The negotiating teams will discuss in-depth a broad range of TTIP issues.

STAKEHOLDER FORUM


During the 9th round, the U.S. hosts will hold a forum during which U.S. and EU negotiators will exchange views with interested stakeholders. The forum will take place on Thursday 23 April 2015 from 11:00 – 16:30 (NY time) at TBD location and will feature two separate components:

(1) Stakeholder Policy Presentations - 11:00 – 14:30 (NY time)

Stakeholders are invited to deliver presentations to U.S. and EU negotiators outlining their views on aspects of the TTIP agreement. Presentation time slots will be assigned on a first come, first served basis until capacity is reached. Stakeholders must register by Wednesday 15 April 2015 in order to receive a time assignment. (2) Chief Negotiators Briefing - 15:15 – 16:30 (NY time)
