I have the honor to confirm the following understanding reached between the delegations of the United States of America and the Kingdom of Morocco in the course of negotiations regarding Chapter Two (National Treatment and Market Access) of the Free Trade Agreement (the “Agreement”) between our Governments signed this day:

Morocco intends to continue to apply its existing parafiscal tax, at a rate of no more than 0.25 percent, to imports of goods, including imports from the United States, following the entry into force of the Agreement.

I would be grateful if you would confirm that this understanding is shared by your Government.
