Dear Ambassador Zoellick:

During negotiation of the Investment and Services Chapters of the United States-Morocco Free Trade Agreement, the United States expressed an interest in Morocco's allowing any persons, including those who are not physicians, to establish private clinics and comparable medical facilities. The United States also expressed an interest in Morocco's allowing any persons, including those who are not pharmacists, to establish enterprises engaged in the manufacture or wholesale distribution of pharmaceutical products.

I have the honor to confirm that Morocco has taken note of the interests expressed by the United States and will take them into account as it reforms its laws governing the activities in question.
