As you know, Colombian coffee enjoys a strong reputation in the United States for quality. Unfortunately, this reputation can provide an incentive to sell non-Colombian coffee as Colombian coffee, in order to benefit from the higher prices commanded by the genuine product.

I am writing because of concerns that our coffee industry has expressed to us concerning the possible mislabeling of coffee in the U.S. market as "Colombian". I understand from discussions during the negotiations of the Trade Promotion Agreement between our two countries that there are various mechanisms available in the United States to prevent such activity. I would greatly appreciate an opportunity for Colombian officials to meet with relevant U.S. government officials, along with representatives of our coffee industry, to identify these mechanisms and discuss how they can best be used to protect the reputation of Colombian coffee. The appropriate follow up of this issue is important.

Please let me know if it would be possible to schedule such a meeting.
