I have the honor to refer to Annex I (Non-Conforming Measures) of the United States-Central America Free Trade Agreement (the "Agreement") signed at on, 2004.
During the negotiation of the Agreement, the United States and El Salvador discussed the non-conforming measures contained in El Salvador's Schedule to Annex I. I have the honor to confirm the shared understanding of the Government of United States of America and the Government of the Republic of El Salvador that Articles 7 and 10 of the <i>Código de Trabajo</i> are not inconsistent with Chapter Eleven (Services) of the Agreement.

I have the honor to propose that this letter and your letter of confirmation in reply shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments, to enter into force on the entry into force of the Agreement.
